

Notice of CVEA Tariff Changes

August 20, 2010

Copper Valley Electric Association's Board of Directors gives notice to its members of its intent to make the following changes to tariff rate schedules for residential, commercial, and industrial services in the Copper Basin and Valdez Districts: All schedules – minor textual changes for internal consistency with other tariff sections; large commercial schedules – add 1,500 KW maximum demand, to clarify size divisions between rate schedules; Valdez District industrial schedule – add provisions applicable to new customers and substantial increases in load, to reflect increased fossil fuel costs associated with significant increases in industrial load; cost of power charge schedule – add a cost of power offset for revenues received from industrial incremental fuel cost recovery charges, to properly reflect costs of power recovered from rates.
