CVEA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS 2024 GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating senior from a public or private secondary school or home school program located within the CVEA service territory. Applicant, his/her parent(s), or legal guardian(s) must be a member of CVEA or reside in a dwelling served by CVEA during the school year.
- 2. Awards are for students who will be full-time students, in any course, which leads to a certificate or degree in an apprenticeship program; trade, technical, orvocational school; or an accredited college.
- 3. A full-time student will be defined as a student taking a minimum of 12 credit hours in a semester or full-time attendance as determined by the trade, technical, or vocational school.
- 4. Applicants will be scored equally among four categories: education/grades, community involvement, future education/career goals, and financial need.
- 5. A copy of your official high school transcripts must be submitted. Transcripts must include the first semester of senior year.
- 6. Completion of the "Statement of Financial Plan" is required. The financial plan is intended to demonstrate your understanding of the financial resources required to complete the **first year** of your educational program. It will also be used to help establish your **need** for additional funding.
- 7. Applicants must submit the attached application and a personal narrative not exceeding two pages, double-spaced. Students MUST include the following in their personal narrative:
 - Personal history
 - How your involvement in school, clubs, community activities or volunteer experiences have helped shape you, or help you determine your future path
 - A description of career goals and how you intend to achieve those goals
 - Describe your financial need (financial need is one of four components of this scholarship and it is your responsibility to tell the committee why you need this scholarship to help you pay for your education)
 - An explanation of why you feel you should be awarded the scholarship
- 8. Applicants must include three letters of recommendation, <u>one from each category</u>: (1) a classroom teacher; (2) a community, an industry member, or employer; (3) and a personal reference. Letter must reference the category the recommendation is intended to fulfill. You will be scored on whether or not you have met this criteria.
- 9. An interview will be required for the top finalists.
- 10. Applications and required documentation must be received at CVEA no later than 5 p.m. Thursday, February 15, 2024. Please include only requested documentation. Other materials will not be provided to the Scholarship Committee.
- 11. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.

The Scholarship Committee will select the finalists based on the merits of this application.

A minimum of the top three finalists will be interviewed.

In the event no qualified applications are received, the Committee reserves the right to forego awarding this scholarship in a given year.

The recipient must submit proof of school acceptance prior to award disbursement. Disbursement of the award will be made to the school's financial aid office following receipt of the CVEACF Enrollment Verification Form from the school. This verification must be received by CVEA by Thursday, October 24, 2024.
