CVEA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS 2026 CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Applicant, his/her parent(s), or legal guardian(s) must be a member of CVEA. Eligible applicants may live outside of the service territory during the school year but must demonstrate they remain a permanent resident of the service district (i.e. CVEA membership number, Permanent Fund Dividend, voter registration, lease/rental agreement, mortgage statement, proof of employment). High school students are not eligible.
- 2. Awards are for adults who will be part-time or full-time students of an apprenticeship program, trade, technical, or vocational school; or an accredited college in any course of study which leads to a degree or certificate.
- 3. Part-time or full-time student status will be determined by the college, trade, technical, or vocational school.
- 4. Applicants will be scored based on their clearly defined goals, intended future use of their degree or certificate, and financial need.
- 5. Completion of the *Statement of Financial Plan* is required. The financial plan is intended to demonstrate an understanding of the financial resources required to complete your selected educational program. It will also be used to help establish your **need** for additional funding.
- 6. Applicants must submit the attached application and a personal narrative not exceeding two pages, double-spaced. The following must be included in their personal narrative:
 - Personal history, future plans, and how your personal situation has encouraged your future plans
 - A description of your educational and career goals and how you intend to achieve those goals
 - Describe your financial need (financial need is one of four components of this scholarship; it is your responsibility to tell the committee why you need this scholarship to help you pay for your education)
 - An explanation of why you feel you should be awarded the scholarship
- 7. Applicants must include two letters of recommendation, <u>one from each category</u>: (1) a community member, industry member, or employer; (2) a personal reference or teacher. Letters must reference the category the recommendation is intended to fulfill. You will be scored on whether or not you have met this criteria.
- 8. A short interview may be required.
- 9. Applications and required documentation must be received via email at mmelton@cvea.org no later than 5 p.m., Thursday, February 12, 2026. Please include only requested documentation. Other materials will not be provided to the Scholarship Committee.
- 10. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
