

## Notice of CVEA Tariff Changes April 13, 2026



Copper Valley Electric Association's Board of Directors gives notice to its members of proposed Tariff changes. As proposed, the changes will be effective July 1, 2026. Below is a summary of the proposed changes.

- The main purpose of these Tariff changes is to add an electric vehicle (EV) rate schedule and to reduce office hours by 30 minutes
- Other non-material changes – Updates for page numbers
  - 1.7 – Business Office Locations
    - Reduce office hours by 30 minutes to close at 5:30 p.m.
  - 7.1 – Financing Assistance
    - Add language that states a member receiving an installment loan must be a year-round member and pay the minimum customer charge until the loan is paid in full; this way the Co-op does not have to track and bill installment loans outside of our normal billing process
  - NEW – Electric Vehicle Rate Schedule
    - A Distribution Delivery Charge would replace the demand charge and would be in addition to all charges that would normally be listed on a large commercial bill
